BlocRice – Cambodia eyes blockchain in future of agriculture

While the technology is in many ways still nascent, it seems already that only a small few of the world's commodities have yet to be traded using blockchain.

Most of these dalliances seem to peter out quickly, but there are a small number of cases where perseverance and commitment has seen the potential of small blockchain projects begin to flourish.

Agriculture, led by rice production, comprises around one-third of Cambodia's GDP and it employs 80% of the population, according to the International Finance Corporation. ([Read more](#))

Cambodia Has More Potential to Expand Rice Market in China: Expert

Although China is Cambodia's largest market for milled rice exports, there is still a huge potential for more exports of the food staple. The analytics were shared by Mr. Song Saran, President of the Cambodia Rice Federation, in a recent interview with AKP, stressing that Vietnam and Thailand are covering up major segmentations of the Chinese market. China needs about 3 million tonnes of rice per year and Cambodian rice market in China is ranked No. 6 in terms of the volume of rice imports and No. 4 in terms of price of the market, he said.

The market of Cambodian milled rice in China, he added, remains small, and consumers are less familiar with Cambodian rice, but more familiar with rice from Vietnam, Thailand and other countries. (Read more)

Cambodia's rice export up 38 pct in 7 months

PHNOM PENH, Aug. 1 (Xinhua) -- Cambodia exported 426,073 tons of milled rice in the first seven months of 2020, up 38 percent from 308,013 tons over the same period last year, Agriculture Minister Veng Sakhon said on Friday.

China remained the biggest buyer of Cambodian rice, he said, adding that the kingdom shipped 155,327 tons of milled rice to China during the January-July period this year, up 26 percent over the same period last year.

He added that the kingdom also exported 144,247 tons to the European market during the period, up 38 percent, and 57,064 tons to the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) market, up 44 percent. ([Read more](#))

Rice exports on the rise in 2020

Cambodia exported more than 420,000 tonnes of rice to international markets in the first seven months of 2020, an increase of more than 38 per cent compared to the same period in 2019, a Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries report said.

Released on Friday, it said rice exports from Cambodia which passed phytosanitary inspections in the first seven months of 2020 reached 426,073 tonnes, an increase of 118,060 tonnes, equivalent to 38.33 per cent compared to 308,013 recorded in the first seven months of 2019.

Jasmine and fragrant rice accounted for 339,674 tonnes, equivalent to 79.72 per cent of total rice exports, while white long-grain rice accounted for 80,739 tonnes (18.95 per cent). Long-grain parboiled rice accounted for 5,637 tonnes (1.32 per cent) and red rice 23 tonnes (0.01 per cent). ([Read more](#))

Indian rice exports slow as coronavirus disrupts supply chain: trade

MUMBAI (Reuters) - India's rice exporters are struggling to fulfil orders due to limited availability of containers and workers at mills and the biggest handling port on the east coast after novel coronavirus cases jumped in the region, industry officials told Reuters.

Rice tariff take seen 44% off 2020 targets

CITING the drop in rice import volume amid the pandemic, the Bureau of Customs (BOC) is now eyeing to collect just P14 billion in rice tariffs in 2020—44 percent lower than what it initially hoped for early this year.

Customs Assistant Commissioner and spokesman Vincent Philip C. Maronilla told the Business-Mirror they would have been close to hitting the P25-billion mark in rice tariff collection this year if not for the decline in the rice import volume as rice-exporting countries decided to control the volume of exports amid local supply concerns.

Despite this, Maronilla still expressed confidence they could exceed the P12.3 billion in rice tariffs that they collected last year. ([Read more](#))

(Spain's Ebro sees profits rise as coronavirus pandemic boosts rice, pasta sales

MADRID (Reuters) - Spain's Ebro Foods (EBRO.MC) said its net profit increased by 38% in the first half of the year as demand for its pasta and rice was driven higher by a change in consumer habits during the coronavirus pandemic.

The company, which says it is the world's second-largest rice seller and maker of dry and fresh pasta, said on Wednesday its net profit rose to 102.8 million euros (93.11 million pounds) on sales that climbed 23% to 1.67 billion euros.

Ebro Foods' operating costs also increased as it tried to keep pace with demand. ([Read more](#))

Iran runs out dollars, India's basmati rice exports may fall

Myanmar Gov't raises minimum rice price; export risky but promising
